

# Bridge Yard Development, Leigh Woods

## THE COST OF THE DEVELOPMENT

It is estimated that the total cost of the development on the Bridge Yard site will be £1.9 million.

Significant economies can be achieved by building the Heritage and Learning Centre at the same time as the offices, maintenance and workshop facilities.

For eight years the trust has ring-fenced £1.5 million as a contribution towards the cost of the development but it is insufficient to pay the full amount. Therefore we are seeking support from other sources, including the Heritage Lottery Fund.

As the conservation of Bristol's historically important bridge and the provision of learning facilities are central to our operation, we hope that this project reflects the Heritage Lottery Fund's priorities.

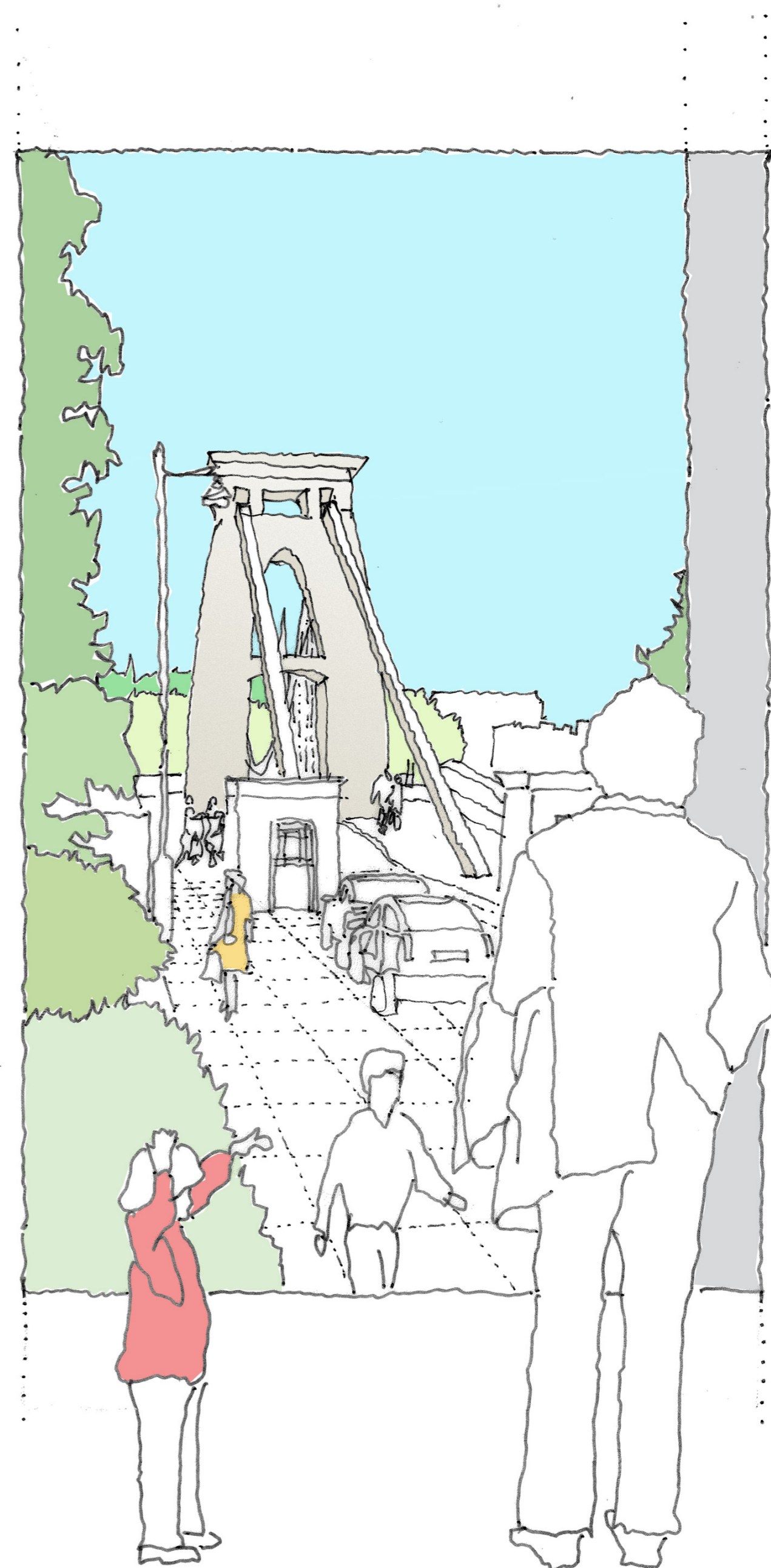

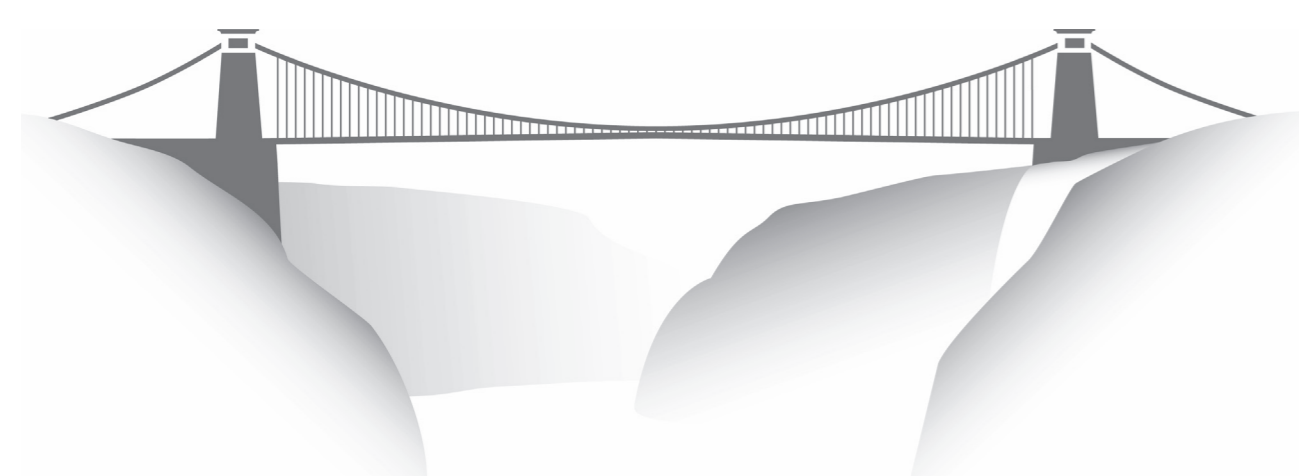
